

#### BACKGROUND - MOROCCAN ARGAN

- Argan trees, Argania spinosa (L.), have existed for over 80 million years
- \*800,000 hectares of land
- UNESCO Biosphere reserve- 1989
- Under threat from climate change and deforestation
- Harvested and produced mostly by rural women in the indigenous Amazigh communities




# BACKGROUND- WOMEN'S ARGAN OIL PRODUCTION

- Title: US-Morocco Collaborative Research for Socially and Environmentally Sustainable Women's Argan Oil Production
- ❖ Overall goal of this collaborative IRES project is to train interdisciplinary engineers, scientists and anthropologists to research and design socially and environmentally sustainable and equitable systems



### PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- University of South Florida or University of California Merced undergraduate or graduate student
- ❖ Plan to be enrolled Fall 2024
- At least Sophomore
- Current U.S. passport
- ❖ Applications due **November 15<sup>th</sup>**, **2023**
- Cannot take other summer classes (even remote) during any part of the program
- Spring 2024 independent study



# WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM INCLUDE AND NOT INCLUDE?

#### **❖Includes:**

- Airfare
- Lodging in country
- Food
- Travel insurance
- Training
- Meal with Moroccan host families in Agadir
- Field trips to some sites (Essaouira)
- Small travel stipend for meals, tips, and other items not directly included

#### **❖Not Included:**

- Hourly wage or salary
- Health insurance & vaccines
- Passport
- Cell phone
- Clothing
- Personal travel in Morocco
- Single occupancy room
- Customary tips

#### COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- Morocco has highest vaccination rate in Africa (~60%)
- Following all university and country guidance
- Required for students:
  - Full COVID-19 vaccination + booster
  - COVID-19 testing
  - Other travel vaccinations
  - Face coverings on plane
- Daily symptom check & in-country protocols
- Agree to virtual program if decided for full program for COVID/security reasons
